Signature of deconfinement:

suppression of charmonia inside the quarkgluon plasma (QGP), originally proposed in [1]

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Why charmonium?

 $au_0 \sim 1$ fm/c



excited states more suppressed w.r.t. ground state

deconfined medium QGP

In central Pb-Pb collision at LHC: $O(100) c\bar{c}$ pairs produced close to $\tau \sim 0.1$ fm/c (and few bb)

Regeneration: strongly supported scenario at LHC due to large $N_{c\bar{c}}$ created - affecting differently J/ ψ and ψ (2S)

sensitive to medium temperature

Charmonium production across systems size Hadronic production: $c\bar{c}$ pairs produced by hard scattering collisions at $\tau \sim 0.1$ and bound charmonium state closely after (< 1 fm/c) Hot medium effect: $c\bar{c}$ dissociation vs recombination, collectivity, heavy quark **Photoproduction:** first studied in Ultra observed in Pb-Pb with nuclear overlap,

and possibly new QGP probe

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 J/ψ nuclear modification factor (R_{AA})



 Models implementing regeneration, either at the freeze-out (SHMc) or during the medium evolution (TAMU), are in agreement with data at low $p_{\rm T}$

- Measuring production in AA relative 0 to production in pp collisions:
 - > 1: Enhancement
 - < 1: Suppression

 $J/\psi R_{AA}$: more suppressed at high p_{T} and showing a rising trend towards lower p_{T}

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• Models implementing regeneration, either at the freeze-out (SHM) or during the

 $J/\psi R_{AA}$: more suppressed at high p_{T} and showing a rising trend towards lower p_{T}

• $R_{AA}^{\text{mid}-y} > R_{AA}^{\text{fwd}-y}$ (low p_{T}) as expected by recombination scenario ($N_{c\bar{c}}^{\text{mid}-y} > N_{c\bar{c}}^{\text{fwd}-y}$)

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- Ο provide a good description here for the J/ψ (see figures in previous slides)

At low- $p_{\rm T}$: **recombination** expected to play an important role for both J/ψ and $\psi(2S)$

° J/ ψ and $\psi(2S)$ suppression hierarchy over the full p_T range and for centrality integrated

At high $p_{\rm T}$: agreement with CMS data ($|y_{\rm cms}| < 1.6$) where **energy loss** calculations







$\psi(2S) / J/\psi$ ratio in Pb-Pb collisions

- **Hint of a larger** $\psi(2S)$ / J/ ψ ratio in central collisions at the LHC w.r.t SPS (ratio described by TAMU model, while it is underestimated by SHMc in central events)
- No evidence of centrality dependence
- ^o Strong suppression of the $\psi(2S)$ / J/ ψ ratio in PbPb w.r.t pp

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Non-prompt J/ψ

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Prompt/non-prompt J/ψ production in Pb-Pb collisions



- ^o ALICE extends non-prompt J/ψ fraction ($f_{\rm B}$) measurements down to very low $p_{\rm T}$
- Non-prompt J/ ψ more suppressed towards more central collisions



Recombination can explain the rising trend of $R_{
m AA}^{
m prompt \ J/\psi}$ towards more central collisions

Models including collisional and radiative energy loss consistent with data (high $p_{\rm T}$)

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Clear observation of J/ψ excess at very low $p_{\rm T}$, photoproduction not only in UPCs

EM fields are producing abundantly J/ ψ for $p_T < 0.3$ GeV/c. Data are compatible with the "S3" scenario (where the overlap region is assumed to not contribute to $\sigma_{\rm coh}$) and

Clear excess observed in the J/ ψ production in peripheral Pb-Pb at mid-y ($p_T < 0.2$ GeV/c) Ο

Models including at least γ flux (+ possibly $\sigma_{\gamma Pb}$) modification can explain the data for both y

In addition model (W. Zha et al.) adding **destructive interferences** can describe the $p_{\rm T}$

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Coherent J/ψ production with nuclear overlap, normalized to UPC



and forward rapidity, also the case for the ratio: R =



No clear evidence of centrality dependence of the coherent J/ψ cross-section at mid σ_{PC} $\Delta C \sigma_{UPC}$







Summary



- O Sequential suppression well studied for bottomonia but now also observed for charmonia, hint of low- $p_T \psi(2S)$ recombination
- ^o Prompt J/ψ less suppressed towards more central collisions (charm quark recombination)
- ^o Non-prompt J/ψ high p_T data could be explained by models including collisional and radiative energy loss
- **Observation** of coherent J/ψ photoproduction in different y regions not only in UPC but also in peripheral Pb-Pb collisions, where EM fields are competing with the strong interactions





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Prospect for Run 3

- ^o Larger data sample \rightarrow will benefit for both mid & forward y
- New muon forward silicon tracker (MFT) will allow prompt vs non-prompt separation for both J/ψ , $\psi(2S)$
- First $\psi(2S)$ azimuthal anisotropy (v_2) down to low- p_T , azimuthal distributions & polarisation of photoproducted J/ψ
- ^o Excellent momentum resolution will allow $p_{\rm T}$ -differential charmonium $\sigma_{\rm coh}$ measurements (with the study of full nucleus vs spectators for the coherence condition)
- Study of possible interaction of photoproducted $J/\psi \leftrightarrow QGP$
- ^o Photoproduced J/ψ could be a completely new probe of the charmonium dissociation in the QGP

NEW RESULT SOON: ONGOING ANALYSIS

Large dimuon candidates collected at forward rapidity allow to perform y-differential extraction

 Important to add more constrains on $d^2\sigma/dp_T dy$

















Extraction of photoproducted J/ψ



- Coherent production extracted using a template fit:
 - Photoproduction components, hadronic J/ψ production, combinatorial and correlated background
 - Photoproduction templates based on STARLIGHT simulations:
 - coherent J/psi, incoherent J/ ψ (and with nucleon dissociation), feed-down from coh. and incoh. ψ (2S), gamma-gamma continuum

J/ψ photoproduction in peripheral Pb-Pb will be much precise with $L_{int} \sim 10 \text{ nb}^{-1}$

Central collisions for 0-10% will be available to constrain more theoretical models



J/ψ and $\psi(2S)$ production in Pb-Pb collisions



^o Double ratio values indicate the relative decreasing slightly with $p_{\rm T}$ up to ~ 0.5

Double ratio values indicate the relative suppression of the $\psi(2S)$ w.r.t. J/ψ which is



J/ψ production over $p_{\rm T}$ and rapidities



 Larger recombination effects are expected for mid-rapidity compared to the forward rapidity region

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J/ψ polarisation in Pb-Pb collisions

- Related to spin alignment of a particle w.r.t a given axis 0
- ^o For a vector meson (**v**), the total angular momentum $(\mathbf{J}, \mathbf{J}_7)$ is:







J/ψ polarisation vs event plane in Pb-Pb collisions

- Vanishing polarisation at larger momenta 0

- Sensitivity to vorticity and B field?

First evidence of J/ ψ polarisation w.r.t. EP at low $p_{\rm T}$ (possibly larger in semi-central events)

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v_n coefficients in Pb-Pb collisions



- Related to initial geometry of the overlap region and high pressure gradients 0
- Spatial anisotropy is transferred into a **momentum space anisotropy** Ο

$$\frac{\mathrm{d}N}{\mathrm{d}\varphi} \propto 1 + 2\sum_{n=1}^{\infty} v_n \cos n(\varphi - \Psi_n)$$

n = 2



 ϵ_n $v_n = \langle \cos n(\varphi - \Psi_n) \rangle$ n = 3

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Elliptic flow v_2

0 a momentum space anisotropy



- ^o Low $p_{\rm T}$ (< 5 GeV/c): transport model implementing **regeneration** can describe measured $J/\psi v_2$, the latter inherited from collective flow of c quarks during recombination

High $p_T v_2$: path-length dependence mechanism + c quark space-momentum correlations

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J/ψ pair production in pp collisions



- Constrains on J/ψ production (NRQCD) and double parton scattering 0
- Ο



Despite different acceptance and inclusive or prompt: good agreement w LHCb result





Going towards small collision systems





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$\psi(2S)$ production in pp and p-Pb collisions



- 0
- Agreement with models at low $p_{\rm T}$ Ο
- pp and p-Pb data are compatible within the uncertainties



Linear increase of $\psi(2S)$ normalized yield vs. multiplicity while $\psi(2S)/J/\psi$ is flat

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measurement in pp collisions

Collective effects observed for light flavours... open question for heavy flavours

• No significant p_T dependence and $v_2^{J/\psi}$ in pp compatible with 0 ($v_2^{pp} < v_2^{pPb} < v_2^{PbPb}$)







Other LHC experiment results

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Integrated and p_{T} -differential R_{AA}



- Sequential suppression for conventional charmonia and bottomonia states 0
- Larger R_{AA} when the binding energy is increasing





X(3872) measurement in Pb-Pb collisions [LHCb-CONF-2022-001]



- 0 First evidence of X(3872) in Pb-Pb is reported: 4.2 σ standard deviation
- Prompt X(3872) to $\psi(2S)$ yield ratio: **unique experimental** input for theory
- Indication for **medium-induced coalescence** 0

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B_c measurement in Pb-Pb collisions

- ^o Evidence of very large R_{AA} in Pb-Pb is measured w.r.t. quarkonia
- Further indication for coalescence mechanism

Fragmentation of jets with prompt J/ψ in Pb-Pb and pp

• Hint of a z-dependence of the J/ ψ suppression ($z = p_{T,J/\psi}/p_{T,jet}$)

Indication that the J/ ψ - medium interaction depends on the fragmentation

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J/ψ and prompt $\psi(2S) v_n$ in Pb-Pb collisions

Larger v_2 is observed for prompt J/ ψ w.r.t. non-prompt while all ~0 for v_3 Ο

• Hierarchy is observed: $v_2^{b \to J/\psi} < v_2^{J/\psi} < v_2^{\psi(2S)}$ however not clear w.r.t. centrality

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
